

Over the next year your execs will be working hard to improve the relationships between Bellway, Trinity and the other Management Companies dealing with the Estate.














Normandy Way Roads & Drains





Centre




























16 road storm drains blocked by builders' rubble & leaves; 6 drains buckled out of shape on Normandy Way & Admiralty crescent



We would like to confirm with the homeowners of Brookvale that we will be instructing for works to take place in the approximate 4 marked areas, to include;

1. Pot hole

- 2. Tarmac drive entrance which is crumbling
- Long strip along road which requires repair and small pot hole
- 4. One soft and one hard standard trip hazard

The road will receive a full new tarmac top, once the legal issue with the S38 is complete.

In October 2024, Trinity recommended maintenance for points 1 and 4; however, these issues remain unresolved as of today.

Additionally Just last week,

Trinity allegedly assured that callouts would be arranged with DYNO-ROD and Southern to address drains that are overflowing with sewage onto Wren Grove.

What's next?

The new care home has already moved from a pre planning application of 64 rooms and now planned to be 78 rooms due for completion in Q4 2026.

Will we see more Parking congestion on the Normandy Way?

Will we see more sewage & drain issues with the drainage connection into the Brookvale estate on Normandy Way?
